After School Enrichment opportunities brought to Westerly Creek Elementary enable students to learn and grow beyond the hours of the school day. We provide a safe and supervised environment, to ensure your student(s) have the opportunity to learn and grow.

HOW TO REGISTER:

Spring Enrichment classes will be housed at Westerly Creek Elementary and will run from Monday March 9th to Friday May 22nd. Registration for Spring Enrichments will begin on **Monday February 10th @ 8:00am and run through Thursday March 12th @ 6:00pm.**

The enrichment registration links can be found on the Westerly Creek website under the After School programs tab or on the Discovery Link website through the registration tab. I am happy to announce we have a new registration "process" where registering and paying for the class is all at one place. Please click [here](#) to begin registration if you are not already registered with Discovery Link. If you are a returning Discovery Link family or already have a School Care Works account set up, you will need to log into your current account and there you will find all enrichment options.

FINANCIAL COMMITMENT TO ENRICHMENTS:

Full payment for enrichment classes is due at the time of registration. Refunds will only be awarded to those who withdraw a week prior to the first class (March 2nd). This policy allows us to fill spots in programs and clear wait lists. Partial refunds will only be considered prior to the 2nd class of the session. If you are a family in the Discovery Link Program, a credit will be issued to your account for a refund.

Participants will not be given a refund/make-up for days they are unable to attend for ANY reason, including, but not limited to, inclement weather, days the District cancels school, religious holidays, or child illness.

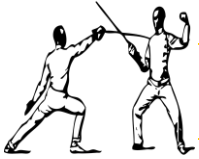

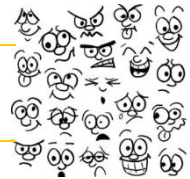


Denver Fencing: Little Fencers (1st-5th Grades ONLY)
